ORDINANCE NO. 2017-01

AN ORDINANCE DETERMINING THE PREVAILING WAGE RATES FOR LABORERS, MECHANICS, AND OTHER WORKERS ON PUBLIC WORKS OF THE FOX RIVER & COUNTRYSIDE FIRE/RESCUE DISTRICT, KANE AND DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has enacted “[a]n act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics, and other workers employed in any public works by the State, County, City of any public body or any political subdivision or by anyone under contract for public works,” approved June 26, 1941, as amended, being 820 ILCS 130 Section 0.01 through Section 12 (the “Act”); and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Act requires that the Board of Trustees of the Fox River & Countryside Fire/Rescue District (the “District”) investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages as defined in the Act for laborers, mechanics, and other workers in the locality of the District employed in performing construction of public works for the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE FOX RIVER & COUNTRYSIDE FIRE/RESCUE DISTRICT, KANE AND DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: To the extent and as required by “[a]n Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics, and other workers employed in any public works by the State, County, City, or any public body or any political subdivision or by anyone under contract for public works,” approved June 26, 1941, as amended, the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics and other workers engaged in the construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of the District is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing rate of wages for construction work in Kane and DuPage Counties, Illinois, as determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois, as of June 5, 2017. Copies of the determinations for DuPage and Kane Counties are attached hereto as Group Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference. The prevailing wage of the county in which work is performed shall be paid for those public works projects covered by the Act. The definition of any terms appearing in the Resolution which are also used in the Act shall be the same as in the Act.

Section 2: Nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply the general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except to the extent required by the Act.

Section 3: The Secretary of the Board of Trustees shall publicly post or keep available for inspection by any interested party in the main office of this District this determination of such prevailing rate of wages.

Section 4: The Secretary of the Board of Trustees shall mail a copy of this determination to any employer, and to any association of employers and to any person or association of employees who have filed, or file their names and addresses, requesting copies of any determination stating particular rates and the particular class of workers whose wages will be affected by such rates.

Section 5: The Secretary of the Board of Trustees shall promptly file a certified copy of the Ordinance with both the Secretary of State and the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois.

Section 6: Within thirty (30) days after the filing of the certified copy of this Ordinance with the Secretary of State, the Secretary of the Board of Trustees shall cause to be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the area a copy of the Notice of Determination substantially in the form of EXHIBIT B attached hereto and made a part hereof, such publication shall constitute notice that the determination is effective and that this is the determination of this public body.

Section 7: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval as required by law.


