

How to Read an OSFM Pyro License Number

- IL -06- OPF 00007 Distributor License
 - IL – 06 first year of licensure 2006
 - OPF approved for Outdoor, Proximate, Flame Operations
 - 00007 sequential distributor number

How to Read an OSFM Pyro License Number

- IL – 13 – OPF – 00007 – 01113 Operator License
 - IL -13 first year of continual license 2013
 - OPF Operator is approved for Outdoor, Proximate, Flame
 - 00007 Sequential Distributor Number (Gateway)
 - 01113 sequential operator (Kevin Paglusch)
- IL -16 – O – 0007 – 1327 Operator License
 - IL – 16 first year of continual license 2016
 - O Approved for Outdoor only
 - 00007 Sequential Distributor (Gateway)
 - 1327 sequential operator number (Dennis Paglusch)

Professional Display Permits - Outdoor

- Professional Display - Issued by City, Town, Village, County
 1. Proof of license (Distributor and Operator)
 2. Proof of Insurance \$1,000,0000 minimum occurrence based
 3. Fire Jurisdiction Approval
 1. Must inspect and approve the site before the permit is issued.
 4. 15 days lead time (or other arrangement)
 5. Assistants must be 18 and registered – listed on OSFM website
 6. Permit must be signed and ID presented
 7. Permits issued are for specific dates and not transferable

Professional Display Permits - Outdoors

- Additional Considerations
 - When will product arrive
 - Constantly Attended
 - How will product arrive (look for placards, DOT numbers)
 - Site Plan
 - Emergency Plan
 - Dud Recovery Plan ✓

NFPA 1123 Fireworks Display

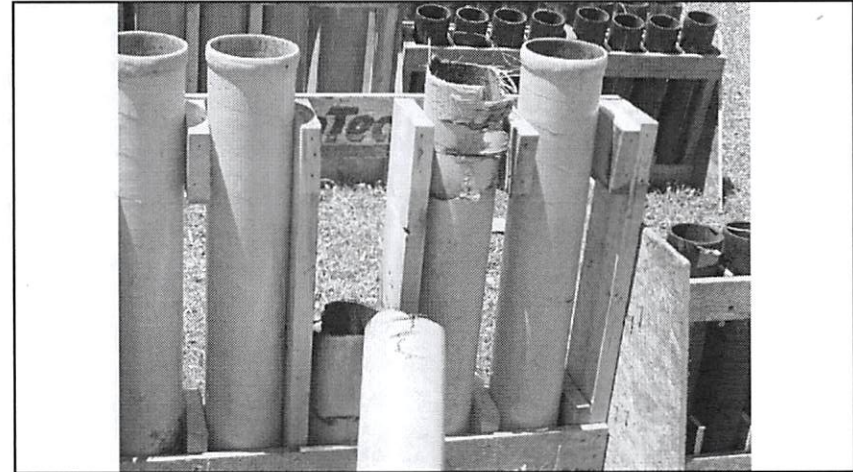
- Racks

- Chain fused mortars are limited in size and number

- 3" maximum of 15
- 4" maximum of 12
- 5"-6" maximum of 10

Chain fusing not permitted for shells over 6"

If there is any doubt of the integrity of the rack, double the distance!!



NFPA 1123 Fireworks Display

- Table of Distances

- ✓ – 70 feet radius per inch of diameter of shell 4 inch shell = 280 feet
- Double this for flammable or explosive hazards
- Angled mortars may be reduced by one third

- Fallout area

- ✓ Must be clear and secure

NFPA 1123 Fireworks Display

- Fall out area

- May have (empty) structures in it
- Must be open
- Must be inaccessible (roped, buoyed and guarded)
- Should have line of sight

- Table of Distances is the Minimum
