As your community firefighters, we are dedicated to serving you and your family. We all work hard to ensure your safety, and we want to deliver the best possible fire and ambulance service to you. The Board of Trustees has approved placement of a referendum request on the ballot of March 20, 2018 General Primary Election. Passage of this referendum would ensure the needed funds for vehicles, equipment and proper staffing.

We need your support! Our district is a separate taxing body that relies on property taxes as our funding source. With this said, the budget to maintain our aging fleet of vehicles and equipment continues to increase annually. If our referendum request fails in March 2018, the fire district will have to eliminate 9 firefighter positions. This will result in closing one of our fire stations, which will drastically increase response times in an emergency of any kind. This directly impacts you and your family when minutes and seconds count.

The Fox River Firefighter's Association is asking for the community's support to successfully pass this upcoming referendum and keep our stations fully staffed with reliable equipment and vehicles.
