

ORDINANCE No. 2016- 01

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN ADDENDUM TO THE MUTUAL AID BOX ALARM SYSTEM MASTER AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the Fox River & Countryside Fire/Rescue District (the "District"), DuPage and Kane Counties, Illinois, is a fire protection district duly incorporated under the laws of the State of Illinois, including the Fire Protection District Act (the "Act", 70 ILCS 705/1 et seq.); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees (the "Board") of the District has full power pursuant to Section 6 of the Fire Protection District Act to pass all necessary ordinances, and rules and regulations for the proper management and conduct of the business of the Board for carrying into effect the objects for which the District was formed (70 ILCS 705/6); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the District has the power and it is its legal duty and obligation pursuant to Section 11 of the Act to provide as nearly adequate protection from fire for all persons and property within the said District as possible; and

WHEREAS, the District has heretofore adopted the Mutual Aid Box Alarm System Master Agreement (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, MABAS member communities have determined that it is necessary to agree in advance on costs reimbursement issues prior to the occurrence of an actual emergency as a result of the increase in the cost of lending mutual aid support; and

WHEREAS, it is proposed to amend the Agreement by the adoption of the First Addendum to the MABAS Master Agreement in the form attached hereto as Exhibit "A";

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Fox River & Countryside Fire/Rescue District Kane & DuPage Counties, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: The Board finds and determines the foregoing Recitals to be true and correct, and said Recitals are incorporated herein as if fully set forth.

SECTION 2: The President and Secretary of the District are hereby authorized and directed to execute the First Addendum to the MABAS Master Agreement in the form attached hereto as Exhibit "A";


SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effective from and after its passage.
